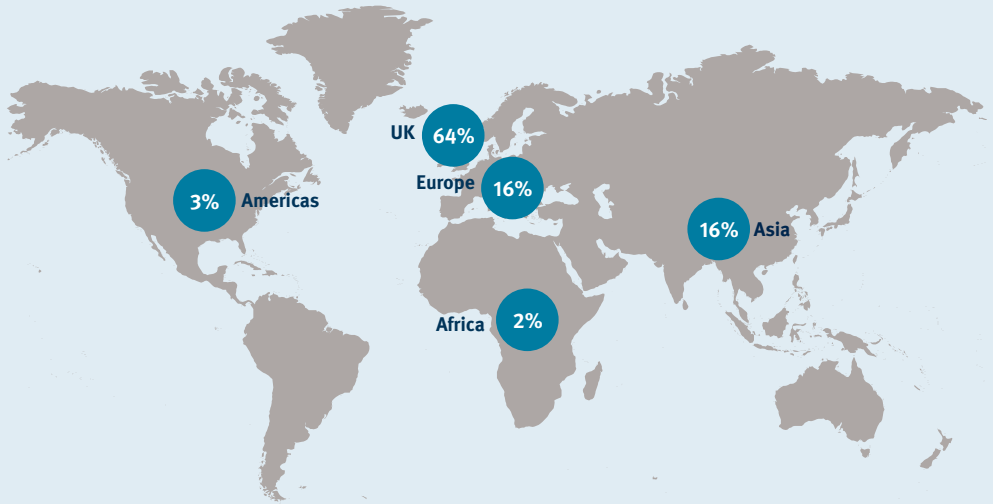

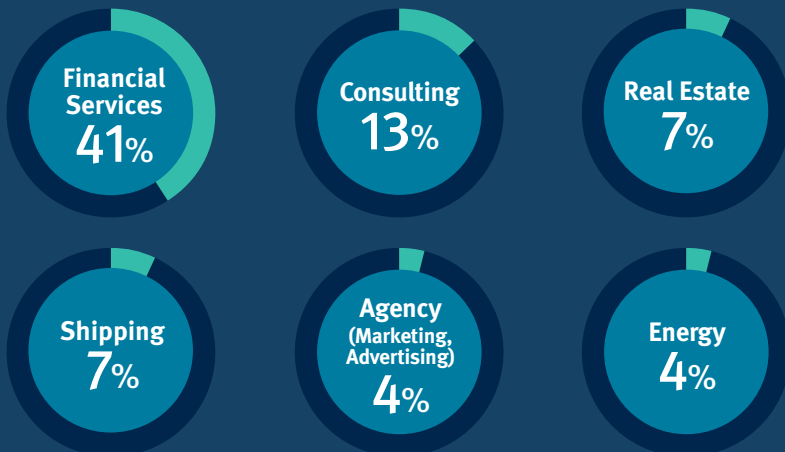

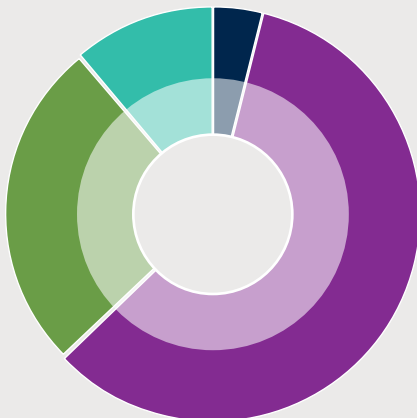

Breakdown of salaries working in the UK, 3 months after graduation



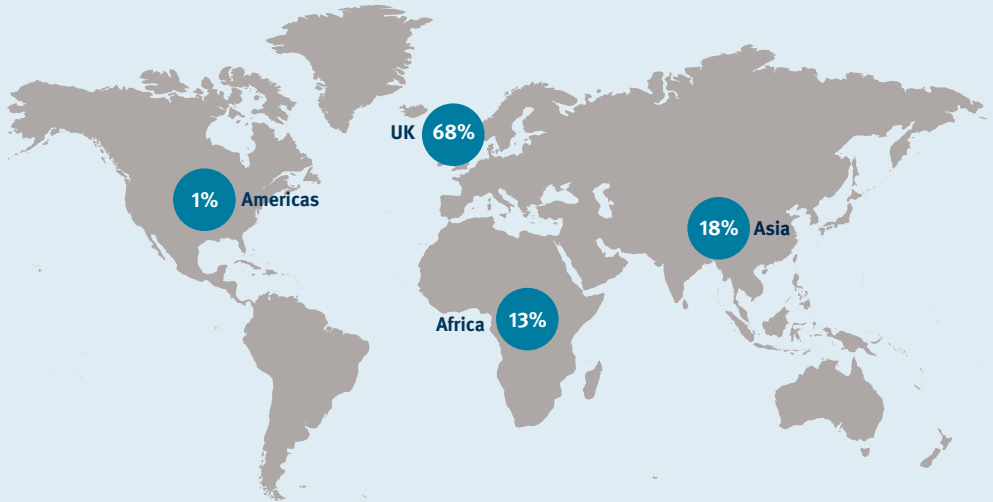
